July Award Spotlight: Order of Courtesy of Adiantum

Courtesy is defined as courtly manners, gentle politeness, and acting with respect for others. This award was first presented in AS 45 (2010) to Telisia Brutusdottir and is given to those “whose actions exemplify courtly and courteous behavior.” This gracious way of being is like a shining light, setting an example for others to make our barony a welcoming, admirable place. Who do you see acting as glowingly courteous? Recommend them for the Order of Courtesy of Adiantum!

For August we're looking at “Ordo Aurei Ursi,” which translates from Latin as “Order of the Golden Bear.”

This is a coronet's favor award that is bestowed at the pleasure of the Coronet, meaning it is chosen and given by the Baroness to an individual who has been of particular help to them personally. It was created by Baroness Katerine in AS 41 (2008) and first awarded the same year. It has only been awarded 24 times since then, the most recent three at Egils last May. With this favor is granted the right to use the linked badge: a sable bear's paw print and a bordure Or. This is one of the few awards that the populous can not recommend, however, this is a good time to look at the rest of our list and recommend some one (or some many) for an award before Amergin's Revival this fall!

Baronial Brownie - first level award for service

Coulter and Cornucopia -mid level award for service

Fern and Quill - for work in arts and sciences

Vigilant Bear - for work in marshal (fighting) activity

Order of Adiantum - for a lifetime of work in service of the barony

Courtesy of Adiantum - for honorable, courtly behavior

Band of Briars - for work in maintaining the lands of the barony

Golden Comb - for especially period encampment

Order of Bastet -for outstanding hospitality to others

Egils Bid: Viscomt Antoine 'a la Langue d'Or

Took last year's information and added 10%. There are 2 different costs associated with the park as we won't know until after the first of the year if they will charge \$3 or \$4 per person, per night.

Budgeted \$500 for A&S village, might not need it, but wanted to make sure it was there if there was a more extravagant display that wanted to happen.

Upped the prize budget. This is to encourage the number of high end fighters coming down. The best way to do that is to offer more of the old school prizes, not just prizes for the winner of the tourney but for other things as well.

Some questions regarding comps: Social media added due to the amount of use the society has begun to use for streaming etc.

Some discussion of adding additional comps for folks like Pikes and his wife due to the amount of work they and their group tend to put it before the event.

Paypal, costs a lot for convenience– suggestion to include a fee for at gate CC use but not if you pre-reg.

Trash and water and biffies are going up by 5% each year consistently.

Worst cast break even is 732, 35 comped.

Budgeting for 850 attendance, without crown presence.

Total amount: \$24,373

Cor Du Val has approached us to do more staffing for Egils for a %. Anton would be hammering it out behind the scenes before bringing it to council.

Planning to have a dedicated social media person again. Website again?

Estimated profit for the highest expense version of the bid: \$4977

Budget approved as a preliminary with the proviso that there is a staff to fulfill it at the September meeting.

Update on the Community Center:

Started using the center in november, got 6 free uses then Xenophone began to pay for it out of pocket, then Antoine and Elizabeth took it over.

Our fighters use it for indoor gathering, bathrooms. Our rapier folks use it. Our craft community uses it too. Murien has been doing painting. Lots of kids, we see new comers.

Had a potluck a couple weeks ago, 40 people, 2 more than fast and loose.

Antoine and Elizabeth spent about \$300 and there have been enough donations to cover 6 additional practices.

Current Price is \$35 a week.

This practice is great, because it provides somewhere to change. This is huge to be an inclusive space for all genders and identities.

As a non-fighter, it is a great site and \$1400 is peanuts to allow us somewhere we can meet as a community each week and be involved with each other's things.

There is obviously support for this proposal. But the request was made to get more numbers from the community center and to table it to be voted on next month.

All the baronies of the summits have at one point had a monthly tournament. Once a month starting in October through February, we're going to be having a tournament at the Creswell site.
